Investigative Guidance - CRD requests <u>in</u> the electronic system for processing CD requests

Investigators should follow the guidance below to ensure that they request a complete as possible set of call-related data (CRD).

When to Make a Request:

Key to meeting our legal obligations is being proportionate, i.e. only obtaining the minimum amount of data required to achieve our objective (an objective which should be necessary in the interests of national security).

CRD is an intrusive investigative tool: investigators should make a judgment as to which request is proportionate based upon the individual case. Consider whether, in the context of operational requirements, an incremental approach to obtaining the data needed should be used. [REDACTION]
